## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Turkey Creek Rodeo Association has requested a revocable permit of approximately 1/4 Section (160) acres of ground for a Rodeo ground and pasture, and
- WHEREAS, the Turkey Creek Livestock Association Board of Directors have agreed to the issuance of this permit.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized to issue to the Turkey Creek Rodeo Association a revocable permit of approximately 1/4 Section (160) acres of ground upon which to graze its rodeo stock.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that when the pasture is not in use by either the Turkey Creek Livestock Association or Turkey Creek Rodeo Association, that it may be used as a community pasture.

The foregoing resolution was on September 3, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
