

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the 1969 Tribal Fair and Rodeo Queen, together with the Queen Committee, Miss Althea Hastings, Chairman; Mrs. Mildred Riley, Vice Chairman, are deserving of reward for their work and talents, and

WHEREAS, the Council desires that they proceed to Washington, D. C. for a three-day trip to visit our Congressional Delegation and for sight seeing.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is hereby authorized to expend the sum of not to exceed \$1,000.00 from the Public Relations Account to defray the cost of transportation, rood and board and other expenses for Karen Wallen, Althea Hastings and Mildred Riley to travel to Washington, D. C. for three days and return.

The foregoing resolution was on September 3, 1969 duly adopted by the vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
