RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, a proposed draft for a Homemaker Service Program has been reviewed and approved by the Health, Education and Welfare Committee, and
- WHEREAS, the Office of Economic Opportunities Council on the aging has offered to meet with the Health, Education and Welfare Committee and assist in the drafting of a proposal for funding for such a program, and
- WHEREAS, a Homemaker Service Program would greatly enhance and improve the overall welfare of the White Mountain Apache people.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council approves this program and requests that the Health, Education and Welfare Committee meet with representatives of the Council on the Aging for the purpose of drafting a proposal for funding to be submitted to the appropriate Agency.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all documents, information, and proposals are to be channelled through the Chairman of the Tribal Health, Education and Welfare Committee, with final approval and authorization by the Chairman of the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on September 4, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
