RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. desires to obtain a permit for cinders and other materials from an old highway department borrow pit situated approximately one mile east of the east cattleguard on Highway 173 in McNary and approximately two-tenths of a mile north of Highway 173 for fill for a dry log handling area near the McNary sawmill.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized to issue a permit not to exceed 60,000 cubic yards to Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. at the rate of ten cents (.10) per cubic yard. Such permit for matieral will be to take materials from the old Highway borrow pit located in NW\$ Sec. 20 T8NR24E.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
