RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the tribe is interested in purchasing additional land to exchange for land located in the Sunrise Project area, and
- WHEREAS, a committee shall be appointed to investigate the feasibility of the said project.
- BE IT RESOLVED that Nelson Lupe, Sr., Robert E. Robinson, Frank Carson and John Herbert are appointed as a committee to investigate the feasibility of purchasing land to exchange for lands in the Sunrise Park area.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the committee is to report to the council its recommendations at the next council meeting.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
