RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, a formal proposal to the Arizona State University for special training funds to be used by the Indian Community Action Project in partial compliance with a contract Negotiation Agreement with Office of Economic Opportunity was made in July, 1969, and
- WHEREAS, to date, no decision has been made as to its approval or disapproval of the proposal by the Arizona State University, and
- WHEREAS, this special training program is of vital importance to the Indian people of Arizona and would satisfy one of their most pressing, current needs, and
- WHEREAS, on July 10, 1969 at a meeting of the Arizona State University Indian Community Action Project administering Board, Mr. Gilbert L. Cady, Vice President for business affairs stated the Arizona State University was committed to Indian programs and hopes that the Indian Community Action Project program meets Indian needs, and
- WHEREAS, the Indian people of Arizona are looking to Arizona State University for a show of genuine help to the Indian Community Action Project program.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Arizona State University Indian Community Action Project Administering Board formally request that the Arizona State University Board of Regents of the Arizona State University acknowledge receipt of the aforementioned proposal for special training funds and they be urged to authorize Arizona State University participation in this worthwhile program.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Arizona State University be encouraged to comment on this request, with a definite yes or no answer, at the December 19, 1969 meeting of the Arizona State University Indian Community Action Project Administering Board.

The foregoing resolution was on November 24, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (b) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
