


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, there are many enrolled children in reservation schools that need school books, supplies and clothing, and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that to fulfill these additional needs, it would cost approximately \$10,000.00 this year.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Superintendent are hereby authorized and directed to request from the Donner Foundation, \$10,000.00 to defray expenses this year and \$10,000.00 for the new school year beginning in September, 1970.

The foregoing resolution was on December 11, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
