

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Bureau of Indian Affairs desires to do hydrological studies to determine the feasibility of drilling a new water well at Fort Apache, and


WHEREAS, there is a definite need for a new good producing well.

BE IT RESOLVED that Fort Apache Agency, Bureau of Indian Affairs is hereby authorized to conduct hydrological studies at Fort Apache and to drill a water well at any feasible site.

The foregoing resolution was on December 11, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
