RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Roads Department needs the sum of \$7,128.60 additional to insure its operation for the balance of the year, and
- WHEREAS, a number of Apache people are employed in said Roads Department,
- WHEREAS, the maintenance of the roads on the reservation is of vital concern to the council.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$7,128.60 is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit with the U. S. Government to be used to defray the additional cost for operating the roads department for the balance of the ensuing year.

The foregoing resolution was on December 11, 1969 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
