FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Seven Mile Road has been engineered and if constructed will cost approximately \$75,000.00 which will be financed through the Road Suspense Account, and


WHEREAS, the Tribal Forestry Committee has reviewed the proposed road expenditure and recommends approval of this addition to the Forest Road System.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Seven Mile Road be approved as proposed and that its construction funded under the Road Suspense Account.

The foregoing resolution was on January 7, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
