RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Century Geophysical Corporation desires to conduct an exploration program on the reservation to determine if there is a Geothermal reservoir thereon, and
- WHEREAS, the tribe has been advised that the exploration program will not harm wildlife or property, and
- WHEREAS, the discovery of a Geothermal reservoir might be of great economic advantage to the tribe.
- BE IT RESOLVED that Century Geophysical Corporation is hereby authorized to conduct an exploration program on the reservation, said program to be completed within ninety (90) days from the date hereof.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the results and data ascertained by the exploration program be made available to the tribe.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
