

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council has secured a grant and loan from the Economic Development Administration for construction of the Whiteriver Vocational Center, and

WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration has required security be provided for the loan portion in the amount of \$4309.92 to be paid annually for a period of twenty (20) years, and


WHEREAS, Arizona State Law prohibited the Alchesay High School District from leasing for a period of twenty (20) years and has required an escape clause by giving thirty (30) days notice of cancellation prior to each anniversary date of the lease, and


WHEREAS, the Economic Development Administration requires security for the said loan.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit with the U. S. Treasury an annual sum of \$4,309.92 for a period of twenty (20) years as security for the above-mentioned loan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this sum shall be included in the annual tribal budget beginning May 1, 1970 for a period of twenty (20) years.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
