

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, funds are available through Section 236 of the National Housing Act for the construction of rental housing for persons of moderate income, and


WHEREAS, a market for some 60 additional rental units exists on the Fort Apache Reservation and the Fort Apache Housing Corporation, Inc. has authorized application for funds with which to build this housing, and

WHEREAS, the sum of \$2898.00 is needed to pay the FHA examination fees for an additional sixty (60) 221D-3 houses, and

WHEREAS, there is great need for these houses to be constructed on the reservation.

BE IT RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the U. S. Treasury the sum of \$2898.00 to defray the cost of the FHA examination fees for the construction of sixty (60) 221D-3 houses.

The foregoing resolution was on February 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
