RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe owns and operates the Fort Apache Timber Company, a Tribal Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors, Fort Apache Timber Company has submitted and recommends approval by the Tribal Council of a general and operating budget for the Fort Apache Timber Company for the Fiscal Year May 1, 1970 through April 30, 1971 and said budget has been prepared and recommended in accordance with the Plan of Operation for the Enterprise, and
- WHEREAS, the Plan of Operation of the Fort Apache Timber Company was approved July 14, 1961.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the budget for general operating expense in the amount of \$4,538,850. and Capital Expenditures amounting to \$682,659. is hereby approved for the operation of the Fort Apache Timber Company for the Fiscal Year beginning May 1, 1970 and ending April 30, 1971.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that no unexpended funds from prior budgets will be expended.
