## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Tribal Budget, Fiscal Year 1970-71, approved by Resolution No. 70-47 established the salary of the Chairman of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council at \$12,000.00 per annum, and
- WHEREAS, the tribal budget also established the salary of Vice-Chairman at \$8,000.00 per annum, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that the Chairman's salary should be increased to \$15,000.00 per annum.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the starting salary of the Tribal Chairman shall be \$15,000.00 per year and he shall be given a salary increase of \$1,000.00 per year based on performance and approval by the Council.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the starting salary of the Vice-Chairman shall be \$8,000.00 per annum with a maximum salary of \$10,000.00.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman's salary be increased to \$15,000.00 plus employees benefits in the amount of \$4,400.00.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the sum of \$3,689.00 be appropriated from tribal funds on deposit in the treasury of the United States to defray the additional costs of the salary increase of the Tribal Chairman.

The foregoing resolution was on May 20, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 1 abstained, 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
