RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Arizona State Highway Safety Division has recommended horizontal lighting along Highway 73 through Whiteriver, and
- WHEREAS, the State Highway Department has notified the Tribal Council that funding and operating of these lights will be a local responsibility.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Bureau of Indian Affairs, Reservation Program Officer, Fort Apache Agency, is hereby requested and directed to explore any area to secure federal and/or state funds for the purchase and installation of these lights.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Safety Division of the Arizona State Highway Department is requested to supply engineering estimates and planning for proper installation of this street lighting system.

The foregoing resolition was on June 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
