RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe and Southwest Forest Industries, Inc. have entered into an agreement to construct interceptor sewers and sewer treatment ponds in McNary, Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe received a grant from the Federal Water Pollution Control Administration, and
- WHEREAS, this project has been completed, and in order to receive the grant the tribe must accept this project on the engineer's recommendation.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby accepts this project completed in accordance with the specifications as reported by the engineer.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to execute all papers necessary to secure the final grant from the Federal Water Pollution Control Administration.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
