RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the Arizona State Highway Department has requested a permit to erect a screening plant in the McNary cinder pit to remove approximately 5,000 cubic yards of cinder, and
- WHEREAS, the materials are to be placed on State Route #73 east of McNary on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.
- BE IT RESOLVED that permission is hereby granted to the Arizona State Highway Department to erect the screening plant and also to grant a gratuitous permit for 5,000 cubic yards of cinders.

The foregoing resolution was on June 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
