RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe conducts a continuing game management program, and
- WHEREAS, surveys indicate that surplus game animals exist to the extent that liberal seasons and bag limits can be made available to tribal members, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Game Wardens and the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise have made recommendations to the Tribal Council.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the attached Tribal game seasons, bag limits and regulations be approved for 1970/71.

The foregoing resolution was on June 10, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
