RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Boyd Knapp desires to sell the Knapp Trading Post at Cibecue to Michael Cooley, and
- WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that Michael Cooley deserves a chance to go into business for himself.
- BE IT RESOLVED that permission is hereby granted to assign the lease of the Knapp Trading Post from Boyd Knapp to Michael Cooley.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a traders license to operate the said trading post be issued to Michael Cooley.

The foregoing resolution was on July 8, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against and 1 abstained by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
