## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the General Livestock Board has requested that no funds received under the 4500 Account be expended without the approval of the General Livestock Board, and
- WHEREAS, the Council is of the opinion that this Board should have such approval authority.
- BE IT RESOLVED that hereafter no funds budgeted or received for range management or development under Account 4500 shall be expended without the General Livestock Board first approving said expenditures.

The foregoing resolution was on August 5, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
