WHEREAS, Dr. Peterson is going to conduct a mental health program on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribe needs to expend the sum of \$300.00 as and for matching funds to help pay the cost of the said health program.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$300.00 is hereby approved from Contingency funds.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
