


RESOLUTION OF THE

FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, there is a need for a closer working relationship by the businessmen of the perifocal area of the reservation and the White Mountain Apache Tribe, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Rotary Club of Pinetop, Arizona is the outstanding businessmen's luncheon club in the area.

BE IT RESOLVED that the sum of \$432.00 from Public Relations Account is hereby approved for expenditure to defray the cost for dues and meals of three memberships of White Mountain Apache Tribe in the White Mountain Rotary Club, Pinetop, Arizona, for a period of one year.

The foregoing resolution was on August 6, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
