FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, Dr. Peterson is going to conduct a mental health program on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, Tribal Resolution No. 70-128 appropriated funds from the Contingency Fund, and due to a typographical error \$300.00 was appropriated when the amount should have been \$3,000.00.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the sum of \$3,000.00 is approved from the Congingency fund.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Resolution No. 70-128 is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on September 9, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
