

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, The Sunrise Park Committee granted free stumpage to the Fort Apache Timber Company in return for clearing the Ski Tow areas and Ski Runs on the Sunrise Park Ski Development Complex, when spruce stumpage was estimated at \$17.00 per thousand board feet, and

WHEREAS, Resolution No. 70-124 established a stumpage value of \$2.10 per thousand board feet after data from costs and sales were analyzed, and

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company has already expended some \$3,324.30 through August, 1970 over the donated stumpage value, computed at the rate of \$14.90 per thousand board feet logged, and

WHEREAS, the Fort Apache Timber Company will have to continue to pay this difference to the loggers involved until the Ski Runs are completely cleared.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the Fort Apache Timber Company be reimbursed in the amount of \$3,324.30 for funds already expended, said reimbursement to come from Tribal Funds earmarked for the Sunrise Park Development.


BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Fort Apache Timber Company be reimbursed each month for the amount expended over the donated stumpage value at the rate of \$14.90 per thousand board feet logged by those loggers clearing the ski-runs, or at such a rate as is determined as stumpage value for spruce by future rate redeterminations, deducted from the original value of \$17.00 for spruce stumpage, and this figure multiplied by the gross scale footage of spruce logged into the Whiteriver Mill from the Sunrise Park Complex each month.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
