


RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the cutting date for the Paradise Creek Logging Unit, Contract No. H50C-1420-629, approved by the Area Director, August 27, 1968 between the White Mountain Apache Tribe and the Fort Apache Timber Company expires December 31, 1969, and

WHEREAS, a volume of timber still must be removed.

BE IT RESOLVED that the contract expiration date be extended to December 31, 1971 and that the date to complete all other contract obligations be extended to December 31, 1971.

The foregoing resolution was on September 10, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
