## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, the volume of business in the Tribal Business Office has greatly increased with special programs and Bureau of Indian Affairs contracts, and
- WHEREAS, there is a considerable backlog of work to be done, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that it should be to their advantage to hire an additional bookkeeper-Accountant.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Administrative Manager is authorized to hire an additional Bookkeeper-Accountant at a total cost of \$9744.00 per annum to the tribe, including fringe benefits.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the amount of \$9744.00 is hereby appropriated from funds on deposit in the Treasury of the United States for payment of this salary.

The foregoing resolution was on September 30, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
