RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Mr. Arch Penrod, Manager of the White Mountain Apache Enterprise, submitted his resignation to the Tribal Council and it was accepted by Resolution No. 70-133, and
- WHEREAS, the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Apache Enterprise unanimously requested that Mr. Penrod's resolution not be accepted, and
- WHEREAS, Mr. Arch Penrod serves as agent for the Fort Apache Development Corporation for Arizona Liquor Licenses, and
- WHEREAS, the acceptance of this resignation would require a complete audit which is quite expensive, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has received further advice from the counsel on the difficulties of expenses involved.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Resolution No. 70-133 is hereby rescinded.

The foregoing resolution was on September 30, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 2 against and 1 abstained by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
