RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, all of Eastfork above A-11 Trap is presently closed to fishing to protect the Apache Native Trout, and
- WHEREAS, a good population of brown trout has been discovered in the waters above A-11 Trap, and
- WHEREAS, a natural waterfall above this area forms an effective barrier to prevent upstream migration of unwanted species, and
- WHEREAS, it has been recommended that the five mile section between 4-11 Trap and the waterfall be opened to fly fishing only.
- BE IT RESOLVED that section of Eastfork between A-11 Trap and the waterfall be opened to fly fishing by tribal members only and that it be properly signed and patrolled by the Tribal Game Wardens.

The foregoing resolution was on November 4, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 6 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
