## RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Michael Bruce Peddie desires to sell and Wesley Loas, a member of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, desires to buy the Econ-o-Wash business located at Whiteriver, Navajo County, Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, they desire that the Tribal Council permits the sale and grant a new lease of the premises to Wesley loas.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby approves the sale of the said Econ-o-Wash business from Michael Bruce Peddie to Wesley Loas.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a new standard 25 year business lease be executed by the Chairman representing the tribe and Wesley Loas being the lessee covering the same area as is now being leased to Michael Bruce Peddie to conduct the Econ-o-Wash business thereon.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Michael Bruce Peddie is hereby required to finish the modern restroom facilities before the transfer of the business is effectuated.

The foregoing resolution was on November 5, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
