RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, Resolution No. 70-168 provided for a new stumpage rate for the Fort Apache Timber Company, and
- WHEREAS, it was not intended by the Forestry Committee and other reviewing parties to recommend changing the present price for spruce.
- BE IT RESOLVED that any reference to spruce be deleted from Resolution No. 70-168 and a flat rate of \$2.10/MBM lumber tally as reported in the Fort Apache Timber Company's monthly sales summaries be charged for spruce.

The foregoing resolution was on December 9, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
