

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, the Western States Telephone Company has submitted a contract to install and provide telephone services for the Sunrise Motel and Ski Run Complex, and

WHEREAS, the rates provided in said contract appeared to be equitable.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman is hereby authorized to sign said contract for and on behalf of the tribe.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that there is hereby appropriated from tribal funds on deposit the sum of \$2295.00 as the tribe's cost of construction to be reimbursed from profits of the Sunrise Enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on December 9, 1970 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
