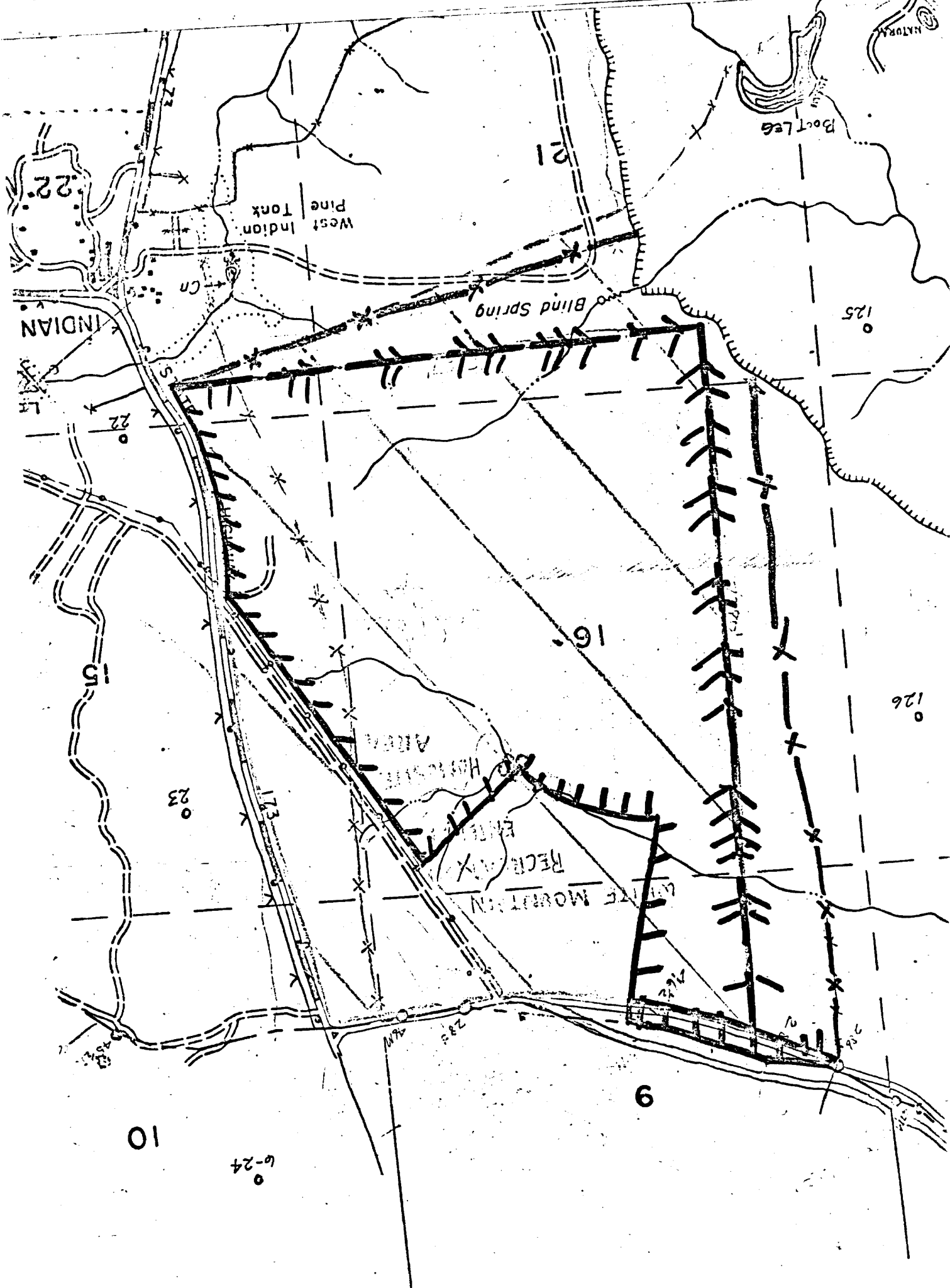
WHEREAS, the area requested is not being used by the White Mountain Apache Enterprise.

BE IT RESOLVED that the area delineated on the map attached hereto marked Exhibit A is hereby returned to the North Fork Livestock Association for grazing purposes.

The foregoing resolution was on August 4, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
