

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Bobby Hinton has had two years training at Haskell Institute as a painter and Ronnie Altaha has had one year training in Utah as a plumber, and because of lack of experience, these men are unable to obtain outside employment as journeymen, and

WHEREAS, these men do not qualify for the Mainstream Program because they are underage and are not eligible for Neighborhood Youth Corps because they have already graduated, and

WHEREAS, these skills as apprentices are in great need in the Tribal Maintenance Department.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Maintenance Manager be and hereby is authorized to increase the maintenance labor budget by \$5,568.00 to cover the salaries of these men for the balance of the current fiscal year. Said funds to come from the tribal funds on deposit with the United States Treasury.

The foregoing resolution was on September 8, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 3 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (k) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
