

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Culture Center Committee and the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council have been studying for several years the feasibility of sponsoring a Drama, which would help considerably to preserve our culture and provide employment, and

WHEREAS, the Cultural Center Committee now recommends that the time is appropriate for action on this subject.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the Tribal Chairman is directed and authorized to apply to Economic Development Administration or any other source for funds to provide a feasibility study and preliminary design and estimate for said project.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tribal Chairman is authorized to acquire information, make contacts, and pursue tentative arrangements as necessary to insure timely and efficient coordination and scheduling of all matters relative to this project.

The foregoing resolution was on September 8, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
