

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, The Tribal Council has accepted the recommendations of the Recreation Enterprise for establishing hunting permits for the 1972-73 season.

WHEREAS, The basic schedule was approved by the Board of Directors of The White Mountain Recreation Enterprise in the minutes of the meeting August 27, 1971, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal interest in improved game management and increase in the resource revenue.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the following fee schedule is adopted:

Elk - Permit Fee \$100 (resident and non-resident)
(Late hunting only)

Bear - Permit Fee \$25 resident, \$50 non-resident

Javelina - Permit Fee Bow & Arrow Hunting, \$20 resident; \$30 non-resident; Firearms hunting, \$20 resident; \$30 non-resident.


Squirrel, Dove, Grouse, Waterfowl, and Pigeons - All species one (1) permit \$15 resident; \$25 non-resident.

Predatory Animals - Permit Fee \$20 (No predatory animals permit will be valid during the Arizona State Game Deer season).

Guide and Dog Permit - (Combination) \$100.00

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the fees on lion and antelope permits will be published at a later date.

The foregoing resolution was on September 21, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 2 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
