FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION




WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tribe to extend these dates to allow Fort Apache Timber Company to finish cutting and perform contract obligations on these units, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Forestry Committee recommends approval of these extensions.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribe consents to the extension of the dates as shown above.

The foregoing resolution was on December 8, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958, and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934(48 Stat. 984).
