RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, it has been requested that additional land be made available for parking facilities at the Apache Flame to eliminate traffic congestion along State Highway 173.
- BE IT RESOLVED that the Agent for the Fort Apache Development Corporation, Inc. is requested to contact the Tribal Land Board to ascertain if the land surrounding the Apache Flame is available, and if this area is available, the Land Board is directed to set aside one acre to be used by the Apache Flame for parking facilities.

The foregoing resolution was on December 8, 1971 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
