

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise is charged with the responsibility of regulating hunting and fishing by non-members on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, on July 8, 1971 the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors recommended a schedule on season and bag limits on small game to the Tribal Council, and

WHEREAS, this schedule was adopted by the White Mountain Tribal Council by Resolution No. 71-109 on July 8, 1971, and

WHEREAS, due to an oversight the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors failed to include Quail in this schedule, and

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors recommend that Quail be added to the above schedule and to comply with Arizona State Game and Fish season dates and bag limits.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Council that quail be included in the non-member hunting regulation schedule approved for 1971-72, as recommended by the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors be approved.

The foregoing resolution was on January 12, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
