

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, there is a need to consolidate the operation of the Reservation Fire Control, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council feels that a central location would be at the Airstrip, and

WHEREAS, it is felt that to start the consolidation it would be appropriate to first place the waterline into the Airport area to service the slurry operation.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribe that an easement be given to place the proposed waterline from the 35-low-rent house units to the airstrip.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
