

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Wesley Bonito recommended to the Tribal Council that the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, the White Mountain Apache Enterprise and the Public Relations Department be authorized to enter into a contract with Channel 21, KPAZ-TV of Phoenix, Arizona to produce a one-half hour TV show, and

WHEREAS, the show would be produced at a cost to the tribe of \$2500.00, and

WHEREAS, this cost would be pro rated among the above-mentioned enterprises and it would be a worthy benefit.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise, the White Mountain Apache Enterprise and the Public Relations Department are each authorized of expending the sum of \$834.00 to defray the cost of producing a one-half hour TV show on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Managers of the two enterprises and the Chairman of the Public Relations Committee are hereby authorized to sign a contract for the said production of the film.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
