

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Billy Kane recommended to the Tribal Council that a new enterprise be established on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation to be named, The White Mountain Apache Tribal Arts and Crafts Enterprise, and

WHEREAS, Mr. Kane advised the Tribal Council that the tribe would have no financial investment in this program for two full years.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Billy Kane is hereby authorized to contact proper governmental agency to effectuate the new enterprise.

The foregoing resolution was on February 2, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 9 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
