

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the White Mountain Apache Tribe has the option of either having a surplus food commodity program or a Food Stamp Program on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council is of the opinion that the Food Stamp Program would be more beneficial to our welfare and low-income Apaches.

BE IT RESOLVED that the Tribal Council hereby elects to participate in the Federal Food Stamp Program.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chairman is requested to secure the assistance of Miss Rebecca Officer, Supervisory Social Worker, in order to effectuate the said Food Stamp Program on the Fort Apache Indian Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on February 3, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 1 abst. 7 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
