

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, sometime ago the Tribal Council entered into a contract with Arthur Young and Company to prepare a study of the Tribal Business Office, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council members each received a copy of the final draft of the report, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council has had a full explanation of said report by representatives of Arthur Young and Company.

BE IT RESOLVED that said report is hereby accepted subject to further recommendations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Superintendent of the Fort Apache Indian Agency is hereby requested to assist to implement the recommendations in said study so that the program can be in effect on May 1, 1972.

The foregoing resolution was on February 17, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 8 for and 1 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it Article V, Section 1 (1) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
