

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, Curtis Nordwall, a Chippewa Indian is a candidate for the Fourth District in Arizona, and

WHEREAS, he had to pull himself up by his own bootstraps and become a well-qualified person for this position, and

WHEREAS, the State of Arizona has a large number of Indian people residing therein, and

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe is of the opinion that Mr. Curtis Nordwall would well-represent, not only the Indian constituents, but all of the people of Arizona.

BE IT RESOLVED that the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council hereby unanimously endorses Mr. Curtis Nordwall as a Candidate for the Fourth Congressional District seat.

The foregoing resolution was on May 3, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
