RESOLUTION OF THE WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

- WHEREAS, a research proposal has been presented to the Tribal Council entitled "The Impact on Resource, Use and Development on Water Quality of Some Lakes and Streams in the White Mountains" by the Water Shed Management of the University of Arizona, and
- WHEREAS, the Tribe feels that this research would be valuable information for the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise and Forest Management and all future development of land and water.
- BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that permission is granted to the University of Arizona to continue this proposed project.
- BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the University of Arizona shall supply the Tribe with ten (10) copies of the completed report.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of $\frac{10}{10}$ for and $\frac{0}{10}$ against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
