

RESOLUTION OF THE  
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE  
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION


WHEREAS, on April 27, 1972, the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise Board of Directors recommended that Hurricane Lake be established as a walk-in lake, and


WHEREAS, this lake would provide a variety of fishing in the fish management program, and

WHEREAS, the cost of cleanup around the lakes where camping is permitted is getting prohibitive.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that Hurricane Lake shall hereafter be a walk-in lake only.

The foregoing resolution was on June 7, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 10 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
