WHEREAS, on June 5, 1972, the Board of Directors of the White Mountain Recreation Enterprise recommended to the Tribal Council a schedule on season and bag limit on Javelina hunting.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the season dates and bag limits as recommended by the Board of Directors are hereby established as follows:
