

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe has the understanding that there will be no further coming Mutual Self-Help Housing Projects, and

WHEREAS, it is also the understanding of the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that further housing projects will be Turn-Key type projects.

BE IT RESOLVED by the White Mountain Apache Tribal Council that the office of Housing and Urban Development be notified by the local Housing Authority that the White Mountain Apache Tribe desires to be considered as a contractor on all future housing development projects on the Fort Apache Reservation.

The foregoing resolution was on June 8, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
