

RESOLUTION OF THE
WHITE MOUNTAIN APACHE TRIBE OF THE
FORT APACHE INDIAN RESERVATION

WHEREAS, it has been recommended that the Tribal Council establish guidelines pertaining to the leasing of lots in the Hawley Lake and Hon-Dah Homesite areas.

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe that the following guidelines are approved effective immediately.

1. The number of names appearing on lease forms, assignment forms and/or modification forms shall be limited to four (4) persons.
2. Any person whose name appears on a Hawley Lake or Hon-Dah lease shall be considered a resident of the Fort Apache Reservation and may purchase a Reservation Resident Fishing License.
3. Any unmarried children of the leaseholder under the age of eighteen (18), and living in the same household as the leaseholder, shall be considered a resident of the Fort Apache Reservation and may purchase a Reservation Resident Fishing License.
4. The clerical fee for preparation of lease forms, assignment forms and modification forms shall be increased from \$10.00 to \$25.00.

The foregoing resolution was on June 8, 1972 duly adopted by a vote of 7 for and 0 against by the Tribal Council of the White Mountain Apache Tribe, pursuant to authority vested in it by Article V, Section 1 (f) and (i) of the Amended Constitution and By-Laws of the Tribe, ratified by the Tribe June 27, 1958 and approved by the Secretary of the Interior on May 29, 1958, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
